2. An exact copy of this claim must be filed with the Clerk of Court at the time of filing.

WARNING TO CLAIMANTS

The personal representative of the estate or any party interested in the estate has the right to object to any claim. If objection is filed, suit in a court of competent jurisdiction must be filed within the time allowed by law, or this claim will be barred. See 733.702, Florida Statutes.
