

LEE COUNTY CLERK OF COURTS ANNOUNCES PASSPORT WEEKS IN MARCH AND MAY

Fort Myers, Fl., Feb. 21, 2017 - The Clerk of Court's Recording Office accepts and verifies passport applications on behalf of the U.S. Department of State. It is the responsibility of our office to review the passport application, collect the correct fees, and make sure that all required documentation is included prior to it being sent.

During Passport Weeks, there will be extended weekday hours, as well as added time on Saturdays. We understand the challenges for working families (especially those with children) and hope to accommodate as many people as possible. The Lee County Clerk of Court will extend the business hours for the Recording Office, one and half hours each weekday and offer five hours on Saturday – no appointment required!

Monday – Friday 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.
Saturday 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Week of May 15 – 20

Monday – Friday 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.
Saturday 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Residents can always apply for passports during regular office hours: Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. (must arrive to the office no later than 4:30 p.m.).
