

# United Way of Lee, Hendry, Glades and Okeechobee tops annual goal by \$100,000

The United Way of Lee, Hendry, Glades, and Okeechobee exceeded its annual goal by more than \$100,000, the organization announced Friday morning, making the 26th consecutive year that the goal has been met or exceeded.

"What we raised this year is unbelievable," said campaign co-chairwoman Linda Doggett, Lee County clerk of courts.

The campaign raised a record \$10,438,361. The original goal was \$10,301,386.

"When we started and looked at the \$10.3 million goal, it seemed insurmountable," campaign co-chairman Robert Shearman, with Henderson Franklin Attorneys at Law, told the crowd at United Way headquarters in south Fort Myers.
